

MAKE A FLYING DRAGON

1. Fold along the thicker dashes to make a concave fold, folding the dragon's body in half lengthwise, scales on the inside. Try to make the 2 halves the same (symmetrical) so your dragon will fly better.

2. Fold along the smaller dashes, evenly, folding down the sides of the dragon's body to reveal the dragon's scales. These folds will go along the length of the body, on each side, and will line up together when you hold your dragon from below, as you would when flying a paper airplane.

3. To fold the wings, apply directions used for folding the body. To attach the wings, follow the directions detailed on the body.

4. Attach a paperclip under the nose of your dragon to give it the balance it needs for flying. This pattern works better with printer paper, 20 or 24 lb. weight. If you use cardstock, experiment with adding more weight to the nose because your dragon flyer will be heavier.

5. Have fun. Create a Thunder of Dragons for you and your family to fly indoors and out.
